



Senate Bill 610 requires middle school students, beginning in the 2009-10 school year, to be enrolled in a physical education class a minimum of one semester per year. Therefore, unless your child meets one of the waiver criteria, s/he will be enrolled in physical education for at least one semester of each year while in grades 6-8. Your child may have the PE course waived if s/he needs to be enrolled in a remedial course. You may also request a waiver if your child meets one of the following criteria:



### PHYSICAL EDUCATION WAIVER
